Please could all children come to school dressed ready for forest school on these days. They will remain in non-uniform all day. If your child's session is in the morning, please supply a change of clothes (including socks and underwear) for the afternoon in case their clothes get muddy or wet during forest school. Coats do get muddy and wet during sessions so please send an old coat for them to wear for forest school to keep their regular school coats dry and mud free!

Suggested clothing for forest school is as follows:

- Wellington boots or walking boots with thick socks
- Long trousers (tracksuit bottoms or leggings are ideal)
- Long sleeved tops and jumpers - layers for warmth



- Waterproof coat and trousers (waterproof trousers are a must at the moment to keep children warm and dry, we have a few in school for the children to borrow but it will be ideal if you can supply your own).
- Hat and gloves

All clothing and footwear should be old or items that parents/guardians do not mind getting muddy. They will get muddy! We don't expect clothing and footwear to go home every night to be washed; they can be left in the boot room to dry and then worn again the following day.
