If your child's session is on the morning, please could they come to school dressed ready for forest school and bring their school uniform and shoes with them in a labelled bag. Required clothing for forest school is as follows:

- Wellington boots or walking boots with thick socks
- Long trousers (tracksuit bottoms or leggings are ideal)
- Long sleeved top/layers for warmth
- Waterproof coat/old coat (school coats can get very muddy)
- Waterproof trousers
- Hat and gloves



All clothing and footwear should be old or items that parents/guardians do not mind getting dirty. They will get dirty! We don't expect clothing to be taken home and washed every night, it can stay in school to dry and then be worn again the next day.
