Dear Parents & Carers,

It has been wonderful to see our Year 6 children back in school, to hear their laughter and sense their presence, bringing energy back into the areas of the school that have been previously void of life. Our systems are working well and we will continue to monitor their effectiveness.

We now look forward to welcoming our Year 1 children back to school on Monday, we thought it might be worth reminding you of some of the information we sent out in our 'Return to School Offer'.

Year 1 pupils should arrive at school between 8:50-9:00am each day and be collected at 2:45-3:00pm, so that we are able to maintain social distancing between adults.

Year 1 children, with parental supervision, will enter through the top gate on the right hand side following the yellow line down to the relevant door access. B3 will be through the Key Stage 2 corridor entrance and B4 through the main entrance to school. Parents/carers will then follow the yellow line back up to the gate.

At the end of the day parents/carers will enter the same pathway, exercising social distancing and the children will come out as each parent/carer arrives near the relevant door, exiting then up to the gate again.

Children will need to bring very little to school. The following list should provide a checklist for parents each day:

- Water Bottle – There will be no access to the water fountains during the school day. Staff will set control measures for drinking with plastic cups for each child
- Hand Sanitiser & Hand Cream – At the discretion of the parent
- A snack for break time
- Packed lunch if bringing your own.
- Hat & sun cream if applicable



Children don't need to wear school uniform for their return to school. They will be need to wear freshly laundered clothing each day that is suitable for the outdoors. Trainers and sports kit are also suitable.

Taylor Shaw, our school meal provider, will be offering pupils a sandwich meal during lunchtime. Children will be able to choose a different sandwich filling each week. For next week please add your child's choice (Ham, Cheese, Egg or Tuna) of filling on School Gateway by Friday 11am.
